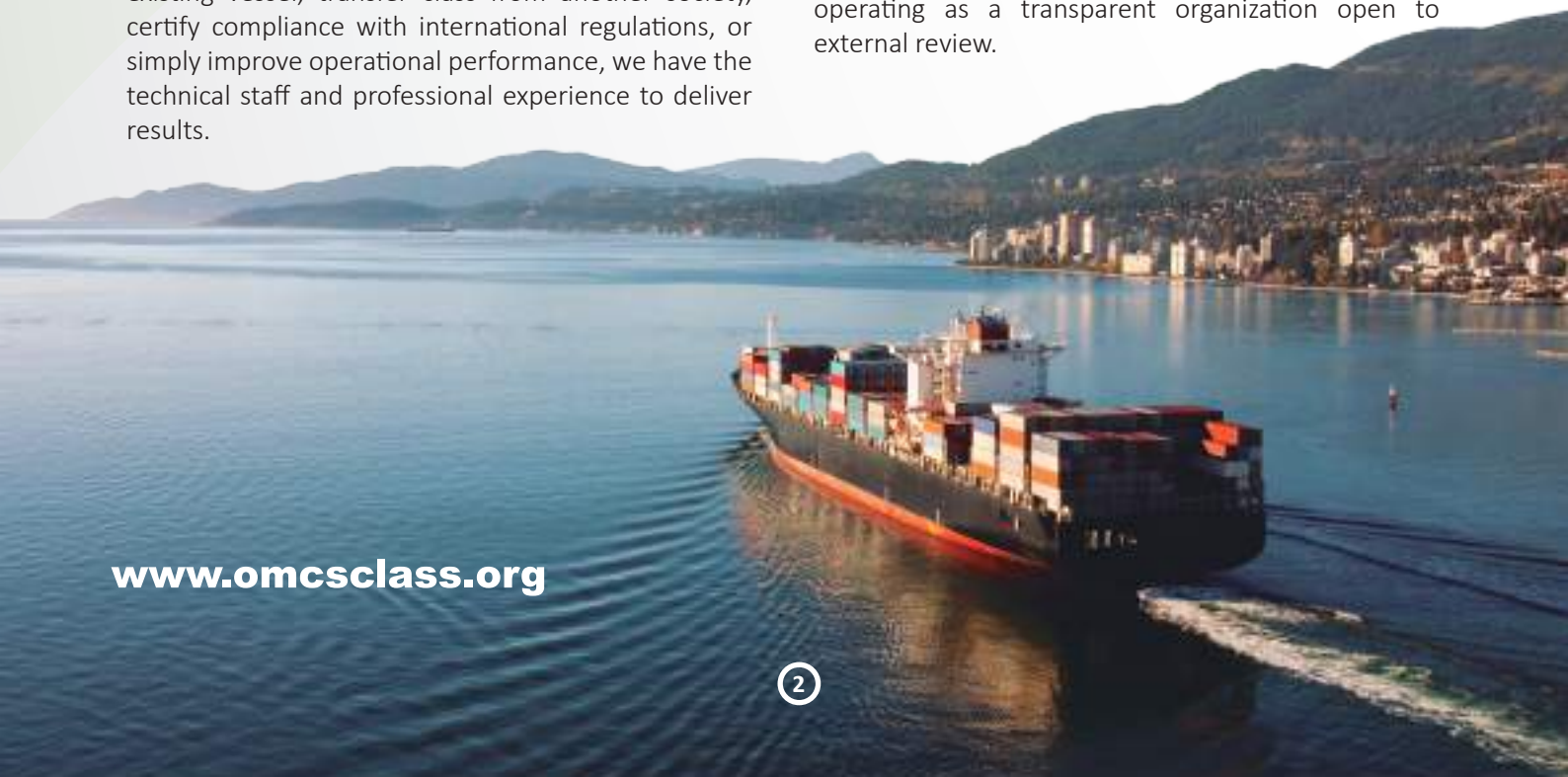

European Regional Office (EURO)

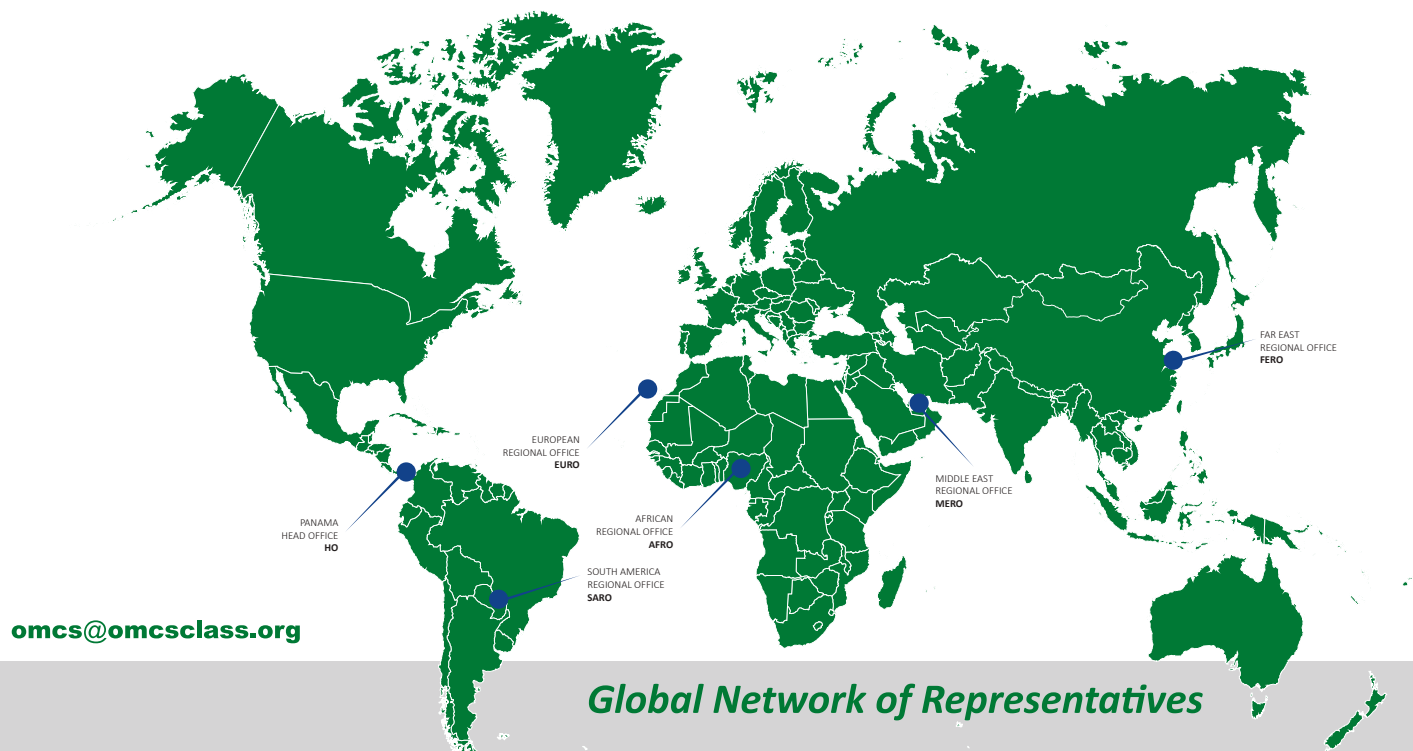

In addition, each maritime administration has regulations particular to their Flag State.

OMCS CLASS acts as a Recognized Organization (RO) and a Recognized Security Organization (RSO) for numerous Flag Administrations, in order to survey and issue statutory certificates to vessels registered with them.

Statutory Certification has a lifetime perspective for each vessel, from initial certification in connection with delivery, through annual, periodical, intermediate and renewal surveys during the operational life of the vessel.
