The International Safety Management (ISM) Code & International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code.

Maritime Labour Convetion

Since August 2013, the Maritime Labour Convention, 2006 (MLC 2006) convention certificate has been mandatory for all Ship-owners, making this a requirement in order to be in compliance with their flag state legislation. The Maritime Labour Convention, 2006 convention applies to ships of 500 GT or over, engaged in international voyages.

OMCS CLASS can support ship-owners to achieve their MLC 2006 needs step-bystep, helping them to demonstrate compliance and avoid unnecessary delays.

The International Labour Organization adopted the Maritime Labour Convention, 2006 with the objective to certify the working and living condition of all ships over 500 GT in international trade.

The Flag State will remain fully responsible implementing and enforcing the Convention through national measures, but may delegate inspection and certification to recognized organizations (RO). The MLC certification process will be similar to ISM and ISPS for ships, and the certificate will have 5 years validity and the process will include interim, initial and intermediate inspections.

OMCS CLASS will inspect and provide the required Maritime Labour Certificate (MLC) for your ships.

OMCS CLASS is fully authorized to perform MLC 2006 inspections on behalf of Panama, Vanuatu, Barbados, Belize, Sierra Leone, Palau, Bolivia, Paraguay, Nigeria, Togo, Moldova and several others Flags.
